STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to authorize Frederick S. Vaill and Julia C. Vaill, their heirs and assigns, to locate, erect and maintain a bridge or roadway across the tidewaters of Casco Bay, between Long Island and Marsh Island, in the city of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Frederick S. Vaill and Julia C. Vaill, their
2 heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to
3 locate, erect and maintain a bridge or roadway across the
4 tidewaters of Casco Bay between Long Island and Marsh
5 Island both in the city of Portland; and said bridge or road-

6 way shall not be built until the consent thereto of the proper
7 authorities of the United States and of the city council of
8 Portland shall have been first obtained.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
