STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE authorizing the State Land Agent to release the interest of the State in any islands in Long Lake or Long Pond in Kennebec county.

Resolved. That the State land agent be, and he hereby is 2 authorized and empowered, upon payment of such sum of 3 money as he deems to be fair and adequate, to convey by 4 good and sufficient deed all the right, title and interest which 5 the State of Maine has in and to any islands in Long Lake, 6 or Long Pond, so called, in Kennebec county, to any person 7 or persons desiring to purchase said islands or any of them.
