STATE OF MAINE

AN ACT to appropriate money to defray the expenses of the
Governor and his Staff in attending the ceremonies of the
inauguration of the President of the United States.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Section 1. That the Governor and his Staff be and are
2 hereby authorized and empowered to attend the ceremonies
3 of the inauguration of the President of the United States
4 on the fourth day of March, A. D. 1913.

Sect. 2. That at all future inaugurations of Presidents
2 of the United States, at whatever dates the same may take
3 place, the Governor of Maine and his Staff are and shall
4 be in like manner authorized and empowered to attend the
5 ceremonies of the said inaugurations.

Sect. 3. That the sum of two thousand dollars be and the
2 same is hereby appropriated to pay the expenses of the

3 Governor and his Staff in attending the ceremonies of the
4 inauguration of the President on the fourth day of March,
5 A. D. 1913.
