STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend section five of chapter eighty-eight of the Revised Statutes relating to the jurisdiction of trustee actions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 5 of chapter 88 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding the following: 'except that in a suit in which a railroad corporation is named and alleged as trustee, the action may be brought in any county in which said railroad corporation runs and operates its road,' so that said section as amended will read as follows:

'If all the trustees live in the same county, the action shall

8 be brought there; if they reside in different counties, in any
9 county in which one of them reside; and in a trustee pro-
10 cess against a corporation aggregate, its residence shall be
11 deemed to be in the county in which it has its established
12 or usual place of business, held its last annual meeting, or
13 usually holds its meetings; except in a suit in which a rail-
14 road corporation is named and alleged as trustee, the action
15 may be brought in any county in which said railroad cor-
16 poration runs and operates its road.'
