## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend section 10 of chapter 121 of the Revised Statutes of 1903, pertaining to Larceny.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section 10 of chapter 121 of the Revised Statutes of 2 1903 is hereby amended, by adding after the word agent 3 in the eighth line of said section, the words, 'except so 4 much thereof as he may be entitled to as a commission or 5 salary for any service rendered such company or corpora-6 tion.'

And by adding after the word therefor, in the tenth line 8 of said section, the words, 'less any commission or salary

9 to which he may be entitled.'

So that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 10. Whoever embezzles, or fraudulently converts 12 to his own use, or secretes with intent to embezzle or fraud-13 ulently convert to his own use, money, goods or property 14 delivered to him, or any part thereof, which may be the 15 subect of larceny, shall be deemed guilty of larceny, and 16 shall be punished accordingly. And any insurance agent, 17 or agent of any corporation doing business in this state, 18 who appropriates to his own use any money, or substitutes 19 for money, received by him as such agent, except so much 20 thereof as he may be entitled to as a commission or salary 21 for any service rendered such company or corporation, or 22 neglects or refuses to pay over and deliver the same to 23 the party entitled to receive it, for thirty days after written 24 demand upon him therefor, less any commission or salary, 25 to which he may be entitled, is guilty of larceny, and shall 26 be punished accordingly.
