STATE OF MAINE

In House of Representatives, Jan. 22, 1913.

Ordered, the Senate concurring, that in order to facilitate
2 the performance of the business of the legislature and of
3 the Committee on Inland Fisheries and Game that the Com-
4 missioners of Inland Fisheries and Game, with the co-opera-
5 tion of said committee, are hereby authorized and directed
6 to revise, collate, arrange and consolidate the Inland Fish
7 and Game Laws, of the State both general and public, and
8 private and special and the rules and regulations of the said
9 Commissioners now in force, and report the same to this
10 Legislature, and said Commissioners are hereby authorized,
11 to employ the necessary legal assistance in this work, at an
12 expense of not exceeding \$10.00 per day and necessary ex-
13 penses, for each person thus employed to be paid out of the
14 appropriation for Inland Fisheries and Game.
