Resolved: That the sum of nine hundred and thirty-four 2 dollars and twelve cents (\$934.12) be and hereby is appro-3 priated to be paid to the County of Cumberland for the pur-4 pose of reimbursing said county for the money paid out on 5 account of the term of the Law Court held in Portland in 6 said county in the year nineteen hundred ten (1910).
