## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section twenty-one, of Chapter one hundred and sixty-six of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, relating to salary of Judge of Piscataquis Municipal Court.

Bc it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph three, of section twenty-one of

- 2 chapter one hundred and sixty-six, of the Private and Spe-
- 3 cial laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, is hereby amended
- 4 by striking out the word "twelve" in the first line of said par-
- 5 agraph and inserting in its stead, the word 'fifteen', so that
- 6 said paragraph, as amended, shall read as follows:

'The Judge of said Court shall receive the salary of fifteen 8 hundred dollars per year, to be taxed as a part of the costs 9 to be paid to him in quarterly payments from the county 10 treasury of Piscataquis county, which shall be in full for his 11 services as such Judge.'
