STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to authorize the inhabitants of the town of Eden to
erect and maintain a wharf in tide waters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The inhabitants of the town of Eden, Hancock county, Maine, are hereby authorized to erect, build and maintain a wharf in the tide waters of Frenchmen's Bay, in said town, on land owned by said town, situated in the village of Bar Harbor in said town between lands now or formerly of George Minot and others on the north and the estate of Alexander Maitland on the south.
