STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Lewiston Chamber of Commerce.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Lewiston Chamber of Commerce, a vol-
2 untary association existing at Lewiston for the promotion
3 of the industry, commerce and public interests of the city
4 of Lewiston and vicinity, is hereby constituted and declared
5 to be a body politic and corporate under the name of Lew-
6 iston Chamber of Commerce, with the same by-laws now
7 in force and with all of the rights and privileges, powers
8 and immunities of corporations organized under the first
9 six sections of chapter fifty-seven of the revised statutes of
10 this State.
