STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to set off the town of Isle-au-Haut from the county of Hancock and annex the same to the county of Knox.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That the town of Isle au Haut, in the county of Hancock, be and the same is hereby set off from said county of Hancock, and annexed to, and made part of, the county of Knox; provided, that all taxes upon said town or the inhabitants thereof, assessed by lawful authority, shall be paid, and the remedies for collecting the same shall remain, as if this act had not been passed.
