STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT granting to Hollis M. Shaw pole rights in the streets
and highways of the towns of Union and Warren in the
County of Knox, State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Hollis M. Shaw, his successors and assigns,
2 are hereby authorized and empowered to make, generate,
3 distribute and sell electricity for mechanical, heat, light, and
4 power purposes in the towns of Union and Warren in the
5 county of Knox, state of Maine.

Sect. 2. Hollis M. Shaw, his successors and assigns are
2 hereby authorized and empowered to erect poles in and

3 through the streets and highways of the towns of Union
4 and Warren in the county of Knox, state of Maine, for the
5 purpose of running wires thereon and to construct and main-
6 tain lines, poles, wires and fixtures for the transmission of
7 electricity for heat, light, power and mechanical purposes.

Sect. 3. Before the franchise hereby granted can be exer-
2 cised permission of the municipalities must be obtained in
3 accordance with the statute in such case made and provided,
4 relative to the location of poles and wires.
