STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 5 of Chapter 117 of the Revised Statutes, relating to salary of officer to attend Superior Court, Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section five of chapter one hundred seventeen
2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out
3 the paragraph in said section which begins with line forty-
4 six on page nine hundred one of said Revised Statutes, and
5 inserting in place thereof the following:

‘The remuneration of the officer appointed to attend the
7 Superior Court for the County of Cumberland shall be three
8 dollars a day for such attendance.’

Sect. 2. This act will take effect when approved.
