STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to exempt the Cyrus Woodman Reservation in the
Town of Buxton and the Pleasant Mountain Reservation in
the Town of Denmark from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Cyrus Woodman Reservation in the
2 of Buxton, and the Pleasant Mountain Reservation in the
3 town of Denmark, belonging to the Appalachian Mountain
4 Club, a corporation under the laws of the Commonwealth
5 of Massachusetts, shall be exempt from taxation, provided
6 they be kept open by the said club for the use and enjoy-
7 ment of the public, under reasonable rules and regulations,

8 and provided that the club shall receive no income or profit
9 therefrom appropriated otherwise than for the maintenance
10 thereof.
