STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN

AN ACT for the better protection of Shell Fish within the town of York in the county of York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. No shell fish shall be taken from any flats with-2 in the limits of the town of York in York county for the 3 period of four years by the actual bonafide residence of the 4 town and for consumption within the limits of said town of 5 York.

Sect. 2. Any person taking shell fish contrary to the pro-2 visions of this act, shall be punished for each offense by a 3 fine not exceeding ten dollars, or by imprisonment not ex-4 ceeding thirty days, or by both.
