STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to provide for instruction in the elementary principles and practices in Road Building and Improvement in the public schools of the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: Section 1. Instruction in Road Building and Improvement.
2 The elementary principles and practices in road building and
3 improvement, in its several branches, including the benefits
4 and effects of good roads, their location, maps and profiles,
5 grades, cross-section, staking out, construction and main-

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6 tenance, drainage, and the several kinds of roadways, such 7 as earth, wooden, gravel, rock, brick and concrete, in its 8 various mixtures, shall constitute a part of the course of 9 instruction and shall be taught in all schools supported whol-10 ly or in part by public money, or under state control.

Sect. 2. Repealing Conflicting Acts. All acts and parts of 2 acts in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. To Take Effect, When. This act shall take effect 2 and be in force from and after its passage.
