STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of the Register of Pro-
bate for Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Section 1. From and after the first day of January in the
2 year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fourteen,
3 the register of probate for the county of Cumberland shall
4 be entitled to receive two thousand dollars per annum, as
5 salary, with twenty-one hundred dollars additional for clerk
6 hire, to be paid quarterly to said register of probate from
7 the treasury of said county.

Sect. 2. The sums above mentioned shall be in full compensation for the performance of all duties required of him as register of probate. He shall account quarterly under oath to the county treasurer for all fees received by him or payable to him by virtue of the office, specifying the items, and shall pay the whole amount of the same to the county treasurer quarterly on the first day of January, April, July and October of each year. On the first day of January of each year he shall make under oath to the county treasurer a statement specifying the amount paid by him for clerk hire and to whom paid during the year next preceding, and shall pay to said treasurer any unexpended balance of such amount in his hands.
