STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE authorizing the T. M. Chapman's Sons Company to bring an action at common law against the State of Maine.

Resolved, That the T. M. Chapman Son's Company, a corporation existing by law and having its principal place of business in Old Town, in the county of Penobscot and state of Maine, be authorized and empowered to bring and maintain a suit at common law in the supreme judicial court of in the county of Penobscot aforesaid against the said state of Maine, to recover such sum as is claimed to be due said T. M. Chapman Son's Company for damage by reason of the building of the first span of the bridge from Marsh

10 Island to Treat & Webster Island in said Old Town, there-11 by raising the hight of said bridge and the easterly abut-12 ment thereof, and such judgment, if any, as may be recov-13 ered in said action, be paid from the state treasury.
