AN ACT to grant a license to build a weir in Little Machias
Bay.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. We the undersigned respectfully request that we
2 be granted permission to build and maintain a fish weir in
3 Little Machias Bay in the town of Cutler and county of
4 Washington, described as follows:

Said weir is to be built on the westerly side of Little Ma-
6 chias Bay and will be an extension of a weir already under
7 construction. The applicants desire to extend the center
8 fence northeast 500 feet and build a pound of 18 fathoms
9 sweep.
