## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to authorize York Light & Heat Company to furnish Electricity to the inhabitants of Pine Point and Grand Beach.

Affairs, and on motion by Senator Richardson of Penobscot, Section 1. York Light & Heat Company is hereby au-2 thorized to furnish electricity for the purposes of its char-3 ter within and to that part of the town of Scarboro which 4 is bounded by the town of Old Orchard, the location of 5 the Boston & Maine Railroad (formerly called the Western 6 Division), Scarboro river and by the ocean, said territory 7 being commonly known as Grand Beach and Pine Point, 8 and to erect and maintain poles and wires along and over 9 public ways necessary for said purposes, subject to general 10 law regulating the use of the same.
