STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 61 of Chapter 7 of the Revised Statutes of 1903, and to compel railroads to burn oil for fuel on locomotives.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 61 of chapter 7 of the Revised Statutes of 1903
2 is hereby amended by adding to said section the following
3 words: 'and all locomotives, except those propelled by elec4 tric current, which shall be run through such lands between
5 the first day of May and the tenth day of November fol6 lowing of each year, shall burn no fuel other than oil,' so
7 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 61. All locomotives which shall be run through forgoest lands shall be provided with approved and efficient armogeneous for preventing the escape of fire and sparks, and all all locomotives except those propelled by electric current which shall be run through such lands between the first day of May and the tenth day of November following of each year shall burn no fuel other than oil during such time.'
