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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

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AN ACT to cause the removal of the records of the Registry of Deeds and the Registry of Probate of the County of York, from Alfred to Saco in said county, and the erection of a building suitable for same.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Before the first day of January, in the year of  
2 our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, the county  
3 commissioners of said county of York, or a majority of  
4 them, are authorized empowered, directed and required to  
5 purchase a lot of land in Saco in said county of York, and  
6 cause to be erected, a fire proof building suitable for the  
7 registry of deeds, the registry of probate, a probate court

8 room, judge's office, register's office and chambers for a  
9 justice of the supreme judicial court, and to procure a loan  
10 of money for the purpose, and assess taxes for the same  
11 in such amounts and at such times as in their judgment shall  
12 be most advantageous to the interests of said county.

Sect. 2. The county commissioners shall forthwith, after  
2 said building as specified in section one of this act, has been  
3 provided, cause all the records of the registry of deeds, and  
4 the registry of probate to be removed to the place prepared  
5 for them at said Saco, and said commissioners shall give  
6 notice of the fact that a suitable building has been provided,  
7 as provided in section one of this act, and of the removal  
8 of the records of the registry of deeds and the registry of  
9 probate as aforesaid, by publication in all the public news-  
10 papers printed in said county, also in the state paper, and  
11 to be continued in all the daily and weekly issues of each of  
12 said papers for three weeks successively thereafter.

Sect. 3. All terms of the probate court of said county of  
2 York shall, after the first day of January in the year of our  
3 Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, be holden at  
4 said Saco in the court room as provided in section one of  
5 this act.
