STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT for the Protection of Deer in the county of York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to hunt, take, catch, kill or 2 destroy any deer in the county of York until November first, 3 nineteen hundred nineteen.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this 2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in 3 the general law of the State for illegal hunting, chasing, 4 killing and having in possession deer.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and 2 police courts and trial justices within their respective coun-3 ties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent

4 jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts, and all 5 fines, forfeitures and penalties received for violation of this 6 act shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving the same 7 to the state treasurer and credited to fines and license fees 8 for the protection of birds and game.

Sect. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
