STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend the Charter of the Camden & Rockland
Water Co.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That section one of chapter three hundred
2 forty-four of the Private and Special Laws for the year
3 1893 be and is hereby amended by striking out between the
4 words "Hope" and "Rocky," the word "and," and by insert-
5 ing after the word "Rocky" the words 'Spring brook in the
6 town of Camden, and Oyster river,' and by inserting after
7 the words "tributaries of said ponds," the following: 'brook
8 and river, including Spruce Mountain brook, so called.' By
9 inserting after the words "withdraw the water from said

10 ponds” the words ‘brooks, river;’ and by inserting after the
11 word “therefrom” the words, ‘or by artificial water ways;’
12 so that said section as now amended shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 1. The Camden & Rockland Water Company is
14 hereby authorized and empowered for the purposes named
15 and embraced in its act of incorporation, and amendments
16 thereto, to take, detain, use, store and appropriate, water
17 from Hobbs’ pond, Fish’s pond and Grassy pond in the town
18 of Hope; Rocky pond in the town of Rockport; Spring
19 brook in the town of Camden, and Oyster river; in the
20 county of Knox, and all of the tributaries of said ponds,
21 brook and river, including Spruce Mountain brook, and all
22 of the streams and ponds leading into, or tributary to any
23 stream connecting said Fish’s and Hobb’s ponds. The au-
24 thority herein and hereby granted, shall also include and give
25 the right to said corporation to withdraw the water from
26 said ponds, brooks, river and tributaries; and reservoirs or
27 basins that may be constructed for the purposes aforesaid
28 by pipes and aqueducts laid directly therefrom; or by arti-
29 ficial water ways to supply Oyster River pond; also to con-
30 nect the same with any of the mains of the company.’

Sect. 2. Section two of said act is further amended by
2 inserting after the word “ponds” in the second line thereof,
3 the words ‘brooks, river;’ so that said section as amended
4 shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized to erect
6 and maintain dams upon any or all of said ponds, brooks,

7 river and tributaries for the purpose of creating and main-
8 taining storage basins or reservoirs of water, and to flow
9 the land of any riparian proprietor therefor, to erect and
10 maintain reservoirs and lay down and maintain pipes and
11 aqueducts necessary for the proper accumulating, conduct-
12 ing, discharging, distributing and disposing of said water.
13 And said corporation may take and hold, by purchase or
14 otherwise, any real estate or interests therein necessary
15 therefor, and may excavate through any lands where neces-
16 sary for its purposes.'

Sect. 3. Said water company is hereby authorized and
2 empowered to issue its bonds and secure the same by mort-
3 gage or deed of trust of all, or any part of its property,
4 franchise, rights and privileges now owned or to be here-
5 after acquired, with such provisions and on such terms and
6 conditions, rates and times as it may determine, to an amount
7 not exceeding one million dollars; for the purpose of can-
8 celling and retiring outstanding mortgages, and paying any
9 or all of its outstanding bonds and obligations, or any of
10 the bonds and indebtedness for which it may be responsible,
11 and for the extension, further construction and improvement
12 of its works and water supply.
