STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Boothbay Harbor to retire
its bonded indebtedness and to issue new bonds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Boothbay Harbor is hereby au-
2 thorized to retire its bonded indebtedness or any part there-
3 of, by purchase or exchange, at the maturity thereof in
4 such form and amount, and with such rates of interest, and
5 payable at such times and in such manner as shall be de-
6 termined by vote of said town, under a proper article in the
7 warrant at a legal town meeting; provided, however, that
8 nothing herein contained shall authorize any increase in
9 the indebtedness of said town.

Sect. 2. To carry into effect the provisions of this act,
2 said town is hereby authorized to pass such votes as may
3 be deemed necessary and proper to enter into and make
4 any contract or agreement not inconsistent with the laws
5 of this state.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
