STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred seventeen of the Public Laws of one thousand nine hundred and five relating to the compensation of County Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the Public Laws of one thousand nine hundred and five is hereby amended by striking out after the word "Washington" in the twenty-third line thereof the words "five hundred and fifty dollars" and inserting in place thereof, the words 'eight hundred dollars', so that said twenty-third line of said section shall read as follows:

'Washington, eight hundred dollars.'
