STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section fourteen of Chapter eleven, Revised Statutes of Maine, relating to county, city and State officers drafting instruments, which they are, by law required to record.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section fourteen of chapter eleven, revised

- 2 statutes of Maine, is hereby amended by inserting the word
- 3 "town" after the word "city" and before the word "county"
- 4 in the first line of said section, so that said section shall
- 5 read, as amended, as follows:

'Sect. 14. No city, town, county or state officer whose duty 7 it is to record conveyances of any kind, assignments, certifi-

8 cates, or other documents or papers whatsoever, shall draft 9 or aid in drafting any conveyance, assignment, certificate 10 or other document or paper which he is by law required to 11 record, in full or in part; under a penalty of not exceeding 12 one hundred dollars to be recovered by any complainant by 13 action of debt for his benefit or by indictment for the benefit 14 of the county.'
