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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

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AN ACT relating to an act entitled "An Act to Incorporate the  
City of Old Town."

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Chapter two hundred and ninety-four of the Private and  
2 Special Laws of nineteen hundred and nine, relating to the  
3 incorporation of the City of Old Town is hereby repealed;  
4 and chapter one hundred and ninety-seven of the Private  
5 and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three amending  
6 an act entitled "An Act to incorporate the City of Old  
7 Town," and designating therein the subordinate officers,  
8 their method of election and duties, is hereby revived and  
9 continued in force.
