STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to permit fishing for white perch in Lake Maranacook
in the towns of Readfield and Winthrop, in Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful to take, catch, and kill white
2 perch in Lake Maranacook in the towns of Readfield and
3 Winthrop, in Kennebec County, at any season of the year.

Sect. 2. All acts or portions of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.
