STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to regulate ice fishing in Lake Maranacook, located
in the towns of Readfield and Winthrop, Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish through the ice in
2 Lake Maranacook, in the towns of Readfield and Winthrop,
3 County of Kennebec, on Wednesday of each week, during
4 the open season for ice fishing in Lake Maranacook, not
5 more than five set lines can be used by one family.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall
2 be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the general

3 laws of the State for the illegal fishing for, taking, catch-
4 ing, killing or having in possession of trout or land locked
5 salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and
2 police courts, and trial justices, within their respective coun-
3 ties, shall have, upon complaint original and concurrent ju-
4 risdiction with the supreme judicial and superior courts, and
5 all fines and forfeitures recovered under this act for viola-
6 tion thereof shall be paid to the state treasurer by the per-
7 son receiving them.
