AN ACT to authorize Enos Sawyer, Jr., of Seboeis Plantation to maintain booms, stop and sort logs and lumber in Seboeis Stream, Seboeis Plantation, Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. To authorize said Enos Sawyer, Jr., of Seboeis Plantation, to maintain booms in the same locations where they have heretofore existed, together with the right to stop and sort all logs and lumber while in transit in Seboeis Stream in the Plantation of Seboeis in the County of Penobscot.
