STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Western State Normal School at
Gorham for the purchase or acquiring of land.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated in
2 favor of the Western State Normal School at Gorham the
3 sum of three thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred
4 and thirteen said sum to be expended under the direction
5 of the board of trustees of the state normal schools for the
6 purchase or acquiring of land in said town of Gorham.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The land which it is proposed to purchase or acquire under the terms of the above resolve is contiguous to the land now held by the state on which the normal school buildings are located. The additional land is required for necessary extensions to the school.
