STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Farmington and Augusta Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. The time within which the Farmington and
Augusta Railway Company shall actually commence busi-3 ness under its charter is hereby extended two years from
4 date when this act shall take effect.
