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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

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AN ACT relative to the taking of the waters of Little Ossipee  
Lake in the town of Waterboro.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The Saco Water Power Company, a corporation existing under the laws of the State of Maine, is hereby restrained and forbidden from drawing off, or in any way reducing, or lowering, the water of Little Ossipee Lake situated in the town of Waterboro, prior to the tenth day of September of each year.

Sect. 2. The Supreme Judicial Court shall have jurisdiction in equity to enjoin or restrain any violation of the provision of this act.
