STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE for the appointment of delegates to the conferences of the National Tax Association.

Resolved: That the governor, by and with the consent of
2 the council, be and hereby is authorized and empowered
3 to appoint not more than three delegates to represent the
4 State of Maine at any conferences of the National Tax As-
5 sociation which may be held during the years nineteen hun-
6 dred and thirteen and nineteen hundred and fourteen. Such
7 delegates shall serve without compensation, but their ac-
8 tual expenses as allowed by the governor and council shall
9 be paid from the state treasury.
