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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

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AN ACT relating to Enforcement of Law Regulating Sale of  
Seeds, Feeding Stuffs, Commercial Fertilizers, Drugs, Foods,  
Fungicides and Insecticides.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The director of the Maine Agricultural Ex-  
2 periment Station is hereby relieved of the duty of carrying  
3 out the provisions of chapter 119 of the Public Laws of the  
4 year nineteen hundred and eleven and all of the powers and  
5 duties which are now vested in him by the terms of said  
6 act are hereby transferred to and vested in the commis-  
7 sioner of agriculture, except that said director whenever

8 requested so to do by said commissioner of agriculture shall  
9 perform the duties of analyses as provided in section 14 of  
10 said chapter.

Said director shall continue the publication of the results  
12 of analyses as provided in said section 14.

Sect. 2. All fees, fines and forfeitures which may be re-  
2 ceived or imposed under the provisions of said chapter 119  
3 shall be accounted for to the treasurer of the state of Maine.

Any moneys now or hereafter appropriated to carry out  
5 the provisions of said chapter 119 shall be expended under  
6 the direction of said commissioner of agriculture, who may  
7 make to said Maine Agricultural Experiment Station such  
8 allowances to cover the expenses of analyses as shall be  
9 deemed by him to be just and fair.

Sect. 3. Section one of chapter one hundred and fifteen  
2 of the public laws of the year nineteen hundred and nine  
3 is hereby repealed.
