STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital, for maintenance and support.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the 2 sum of one hundred and forty-three thousand, two hun-3 dred eighty-seven dollars and sixteen cents (\$143,287.16), 4 to be paid to the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital for the use 5 of said institution for the year 1913, and one hundred forty-6 five thousand, nine hundred ninety-one dollars and sixteen 7 cents (\$145,991.16), for use of said institution for the year 8 1914, for maintenance and support of state insane beneficiaries, including the salaries of officers and employes, supplies, fuel, lights, power, water, medical supplies and attendance, repairs to buildings; furnishings and maintenance of 12 same—labor and material; maintenance of farm, garden,

13 stable, hog department; laundry, general administration ex14 penses; books, blank forms, printing; ordinary renovations
15 of, and additions to, buildings, maintenance and improve16 ment of grounds, roads and sidewalks; all expenses neces17 sary and incident to the transportation and support at Chase
18 Island, of patients, officers and employes, and all expenses
19 necessary and incidental to the proper and efficient conduct
20 and management of all the affairs of the hospital.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The foregoing estimates are based on the cost of 1912 and the approximate increase less the estimated income from all sources, as follows:
