STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT for better protection of automobile garage keepers and owners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Whoever puts an automobile in a public garage 2 or other place where automobiles are stored for hire, and 3 without having an express agreement for credit, procures 4 supplies, accessories or accommodation for himself or said 5 automobile, and with intent to defraud the owner or keeper 6 of said garage, removes or causes to be removed any such

7 automobile from such garage without paying the proper

8 charges due for repairs, supplies, accessories and accommo-

9 dation furnished thereon shall be punished by imprisonment 10 not exceeding three months or by fine not exceeding one 11 hundred dollars.

Sect. 2. In order for the owner or keeper of such a garage 2 to obtain the benefits of this act, a printed copy thereof must 3 be posted up in some conspicuous place in said garage.
