## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to appropriate moneys for the payment of salaries fixed by law for the year one thousand nine hundred and thirteen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. In order to provide for the payment of salaries

- 2 fixed by law, for the current fiscal year one thousand nine
- 3 hundred and thirteen, the following sums are hereby ap-
- 4 propriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, and,
- 5 except where otherwise specially provided, the governor
- 6 with the advice and consent of the council, is hereby author-
- 7 ized at any time prior to the first day of January, one thou-
- 8 sand nine hundred and fourteen, to draw his warrant on
- 9 the state treasurer for the same.
