HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the entry of nolle prosequi in criminal
cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No entry of nolle prosequi shall be made in
2 any criminal case by the attorney for the State without the
3 consent of the presiding justice, such consent to be entered
4 of record.
