STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter eighty-seven of the Public Laws of nincteen hundred and eleven, in relation to employment agencies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter eighty-seven of the

- 2 Public Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven is hereby
- 3 amended by changing in the twelfth line the word "twenty-
- 4 five" to 'ten,' so that said section as amended shall read as 5 follows:
- 'Section 1. No person shall open, keep or carry on any 7 employment agency in the state of Maine, unless every such

8 person shall procure a license therefor from the municipal 9 officers of the town where such employment agency is to be 10 located. Any person who shall open or conduct any such 11 agency without first procuring such license shall be guilty 12 of a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine of not 13 less than fifty dollars and not exceeding three hundred dollars, or upon failure to pay such fine by imprisonment for 15 a period not exceeding six months and not less than one 16 month, or both, at the discretion of the court. Such license 17 shall be granted upon the payment to said municipal officers 18 annually of a fee of ten dollars. Such license shall be 19 signed by a majority of the said municipal officers and shall 20 continue in force from May first to May first of the succeeding year.'
