STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend section 5 of chapter 251 of the Private and Special Laws of 1907 as amended by chapter 28 of the Private and Special Laws of 1909 relating to the protection of alewives, shad and sturgeon in various rivers in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 5 of Chapter 251 of the Private and
2 Special Laws of 1907, as amended by chapter 28 of the Pri-
3 vate and Special Laws of 1909, is hereby amended by sub-
4 stituting the word "July" for the word "June" in the last
5 line thereof, so that said section, as amended, shall read as
6 follows:

'Sect. 5. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
8 take, catch or kill any sturgeon in the Kennebec river or its
9 tributaries and Merrymeeting Bay between July fifteenth
10 and March first.'
