STATE OF MAINE .

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the City of Ellsworth.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor and Aldermen and the Ward Offi-2 cers of the City of Ellsworth shall be elected by a plurality 3 vote.

Sect. 2. The Street Commissioner shall be elected by a 2 plurality vote of the qualified electors of the city and shall 3 receive such compensation as the Aldermen shall vote there-4 for.

Sect. 3. All City and Ward Officers elected by the people 2 shall hold their offices for one year from the second Monday 3 of March and until their successors are elected and quali-4 fied.

Sect. 4. In case of vacancy in the Ward Officers or that of2 Street Commissioner the vacancy shall be filled by appoint-3 ment by the Aldermen, such appointee to hold the office for4 the remainder of the term.

Sect. 5. All parts of the City Charter and of amendments 2 and additions thereto inconsistent with this act are repealed.
