IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to authorize the Valley Cemetery Company located  
at Greene in the County of Androscoggin to take land by right  
of eminent domain for burial purposes.

---

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The Valley Cemetery Company, a corporation  
2 duly established by law and located at Greene in the County  
3 of Androscoggin, is hereby authorized to purchase or take  
4 and hold by right of eminent domain for burial purposes a  
5 certain piece or parcel of land situated in Greene on the  
6 north side of the Old County Road leading from Lewiston  
7 through Greene Corner and bounded as follows: Begin-  
8 ning at the southwest corner of the Universalist meeting

9 house lot where it meets the road; thence southwesterly by  
10 the line of the road thirty-two (32) rods; thence north ten  
11 (10) rods; thence northeasterly thirty-two (32) rods;  
12 thence south ten (10) rods to the first named bounds, con-  
13 taining two (2) acres. And the said Valley Cemetery Com-  
14 pany shall pay the owner for the value of the land so taken,  
15 and hold the same in trust for the inhabitants of Greene.  
16 The said Valley Cemetery Company is hereby authorized to  
17 divide said plot of real estate into lots and sell to any inhab-  
18 itant of the said town of Greene by good and sufficient deed  
19 the right or easement to bury dead bodies therein, subject  
20 to such rules and regulations as the directors of said cor-  
21 poration may formulate for the protection of public health  
22 and convenience.

Sect. 2. In case the Valley Cemetery Company and the  
2 owner of said land are unable to agree as to the amount to  
3 be paid by the said Valley Cemetery Company to the owner  
4 for the land taken as aforesaid then the damages for the  
5 land so taken shall be estimated and paid for as in the case  
6 of the taking of lands for railroads.
