IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 10 of Chapter 121 of the Revised
Statutes of 1903, pertaining to Larceny.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That section 10 of chapter 121 of the Revised
2 Statutes of 1903 is hereby amended, by adding after the
3 word "who" in the seventh line of said section, the word
4 'fraudulently,' so that said section, as amended, shall read
5 as follows:

'Sect. 10. Whoever embezzles, or fraudulently converts
7 to his own use, or secretes with intent to embezzle or fraud-
8 ulently convert to his own use, money, goods or property
9 delivered to him, or any part thereof, which may be the

10 subject of larceny, shall be deemed guilty of larceny, and
11 shall be punished accordingly. And any insurance agent,
12 or agent of any corporation doing business in this state,
13 who fraudulently appropriates to his own use any money,
14 or substitutes for money, received by him as such agent,
15 or neglects or refuses to pay over and deliver the same to
16 the party entitled to receive it, for thirty days after written
17 demand upon him therefor, is guilty of larceny, and shall
18 be punished accordingly.'
