STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of W. J. Maybury, Secretary of the Committee on Insane Hospitals.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of twenty-six dollars and seventy cents (\$26.70) to 3 be paid to W. J. Maybury, secretary of the Committee on 4 Insane Hospitals, for expenses incurred in taking the In-5 sane Hospital Committee to visit the hospital at Bangor; 6 accompanied by a statement of facts.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

On Friday, Feb. 7, 1913, the members of the Joint Standing Committee on Insane Hospitals visited the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital at Bangor on official business. Mr. Maybury, as secretary for the committee, purchased 1215 miles of mileage and a total cost of \$24.30 and expended \$2.40 for street car fares, a total of \$26.70.
