STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT amending Section 14 of Chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes and subsequent amendment thereof relating to the pharmacy law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section fourteen of chapter thirty, Revised 2 Statutes as amended by chapter seventy-four Public Laws 3 ninetcen hundred and seven and chapter two hundred and 4 one Public Laws of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby 5 further amended by repealing said section fourteen and in-6 serting in place thereof the following:

'Section 14. Any person, firm or corporation may conduct

8 an apothecary store without the certificate required by this 9 chapter, provided, the owner or member of the firm who is 10 not a registered apothecary does not personally do any of 11 the duties of an apothecary and, provided, there is in such 12 store a duly registered apothecary who has sole charge of 13 compounding, putting up and dispensing medicines and 14 drugs under the provisions hereof, and provided, in the 15 case of a corporation that the person or persons actively in 16 charge of said store are registered apothecaries and bona 17 fide holders of a majority of the stock of the corporation.'

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
