STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to Special Insurance Brokers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 99 of chapter 49 of the Revised Stat-2 utes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sect. 99. The insurance commissioner may annually issue

4 licenses to citizens of this state, already agents of one or

5 more duly authorized fire insurance companies, subject to

6 revocation at any time, permitting the person named therein

7 to procure policies of fire insurance on property in this

8 state in foreign insurance companies not authorized to

9 transact business in this state. Before the person named

to in such a license shall procure any insurance in such com-11 panies on any property in this state he shall in every case, 12 execute and file with the insurance commissioner an affi-13 davit that he is unable to procure, in companies admitted 14 to do business in the state, the amount of insurance neces-15 sary to protect said property, and shall only procure insur-16 ance under such license after he has procured insurance in 17 companies admitted to do business in this state, to the full 18 amount which said companies are willing to write on said 19 property; provided, that such licensed person shall not be 20 required to offer any portion of such insurance to any com-21 pany which is not possessed of cash assets amounting to at 22 least twenty-five thousand dollars, or one which has, within 23 the preceding twelve months, been in an impaired condition. 24 Each person so licensed shall keep a separate account of 25 the business done under the license, a certified copy of 26 which account he shall forthwith file with the insurance 27 commissioner, showing the exact amount of such insurance 28 placed for any person, firm or corporation, the gross pre-20 mium charged thereon, the companies in which the same 30 is placed, the date of the policies and the term thereof, and 31 also a report in the same detail of all such policies canceled, 32 and the gross return premiums thereon, and before receiv-33 ing such license shall execute and deliver to the treasurer 34 of state a bond in the penal sum of five hundred dollars, 35 with such sureties as the governor and council shall ap-36 prove, with a condition that the licensee will faithfully com37 ply with all the requirements of this section, and will file 38 with the treasurer of state, in January of each year, a 39 sworn statement of the gross premiums charged for insur-40 ance procured or placed and the gross returned premiums 41 on such insurance canceled under such license during the 42 year ending on the thirty-first day of December next pre-43 ceding, and at the time of filing such statement will pay 44 into the treasury of state a sum equal to two per cent of 45 such gross premiums, less such returned premiums so re-46 ported."
