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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

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AN ACT relating to the fire departments of the several cities  
and towns.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. All the present and future members of the  
2 fire department of every city and town in the state shall  
3 continue in the service of the department of each city and  
4 town unless removed by the municipal officers for ineffi-  
5 ciency or other cause or retired on arrival at the age limit  
6 of sixty years.

Sect. 2. The organization and discipline of each fire de-  
2 partment in each city and town, and the appointment of its  
3 members whenever vacancies occur shall be regulated and

4 controlled, and subject to, the ordinances of the municipal  
5 officers of the several cities and towns.

Sect. 3. All acts, parts of acts and ordinances of the sev-  
2 eral cities and towns inconsistent herewith are hereby re-  
3 pealed.
