STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter thirty of the Revised Statutes as amended by Chapter seventy-four of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, and Chapter two hundred and one of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and nine, relating to apothecaries and the sale of poisons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. Section nine of chapter thirty of the Revised
2 Statutes as amended by chapter seventy-four of the Public
3 Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, and chapter two hun4 dred and one of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and
5 nine, is hereby repealed.
